# 8天7晚醉美江西+武夷山

#### 第1天 吉隆坡 河南昌 (机上用餐/晚餐)

从吉隆坡机场雪邦国际机场出发,乘搭客机飞往中国江西省省会 - 南昌。抵步后,由当地导游迎接,前往游览【万寿官历史文化街区】,由历史民居、商业街区、万寿官宗教文化区三个部分组成。晚餐后,入住酒店。

## 第2天 南昌二九江 (1.5小时) (早/午/晚餐)

早餐后,游览<mark>【滕王阁】</mark>是南昌的象征。始建于唐朝,因诗人王勃所作《滕王阁序》而闻名于世,与岳阳楼、黄鹤楼并称为"江南三大名。<mark>【东林寺大佛】</mark>是佛教净土宗的发源地,大佛是中国及全球第一高阿弥陀佛像,佛像身高48米,总高81米,动用48千克黄金为大佛镀金。景区以四十八米阿弥陀佛接引铜像为核心,组成部分包括净土文化区、新东林寺、比丘尼院、隐逸文化区、安养区、海会堂、大德精舍区等。

#### 第3天 九江 景徳镇 (1.5小时) | 婺源 (1.5小时) (平/午/※)

【景德镇】是闻名遐迩的瓷器之都、瓷器在这里被艺术家们赋予了美感,从泥土里绽放出生命,千百年来薪火相传,延续着它由古至今所带来的繁华和骄傲,成中国的标志之一。【皇窑】是国家级非物质文化遗产(手工制瓷)生产性保护和研究示范基地、是一个全景再现、活态传承、真实演绎历代皇家御密制瓷技艺为核心内容的皇窑陶瓷文化旅游景区。【婺女洲景区】: 婺女洲度假区以婺女飞天传说为核心,集实景演艺、亲子游乐、文化景点、酒店会展、美食餐饮、休闲购物六大业态为一体的综合型的中国徽艺文化旅游度假胜地. 特色景点:【金庸馆】,【非遗打铁花】,【水幕光彩《五显金光》】。

## 第4天 婺源篁岭 望仙谷夜景 (1.0小时) 呈上饶 (1.5小时) (平/午/※)

【**篁岭+缆车上下**】挂在山崖上的古村,地无三尺平,数百年来,村民早已习惯用平和的心态与崎岖的地形"交流"。 自然条件的局限却激发了先民的想象和创造力,从而在无意间造就了一处中国绝无仅有的"晒秋人家"风情画。 篁岭古村 数百栋微派古民居在百米落差的坡面错落有序,每当日出山头,晨曦映照 ,整个山间村落饱经沧桑的徽式民居土砖外墙与晒架上、圆圆晒匾里五彩缤纷丰收果实组合,绘就出世界独一无二的"晒秋"农俗景观、最美的乡村符号。【望仙谷夜景】坐落于江西上饶的望仙谷,是无数人梦中的神仙地。悬崖之上,高山清流,在悬崖上望向对面的瀑布,如白炼垂空,银段挂壁,每当夜色来临,灯光亮起,一个人间仙境便映入眼眸。山谷悠远清幽、溪水欢腾、卵石飞瀑。有江西民居特有的夯土墙、青石板路、黄墙黛瓦、原味村屋;也有松涛竹海和独具风情的黄家街市。特色景点:【青云桥】,【三叠水】,【揽月桥】,【望仙谷夜景】。

#### 第5天 上饶 武夷山景区@天游峰+九曲溪竹筏(1.0小时) 宝宋街(围炉煮茶)(平/午/晚餐)

武夷山【天游峰景区】天游峰为武夷山第一险峰,每当雨后乍晴,晨曦初露之时,白茫茫的烟云,弥山漫谷,犹如大海的波涛,汹涌澎湃。登峰巅,望云海,变幻莫测,宛如置身于蓬莱仙境,遨游于天官琼阁,故名天游。 【九曲溪竹筏】是武夷山脉主峰~黄岗山西南麓的溪流,因有三弯九曲之胜,故名为九曲溪。九曲溪澄澈清莹,盈盈一水,折为九曲。九曲景色各不相同,两

## 第6天 武夷山@大红袍景区+体验采茶+++上饶站||鹰潭市(1.5小时)(平/午/晚餐)

【大红袍景区】武夷山大红袍是武夷山最负盛名的茶,被誉为"茶中之王",生长在九龙窠内的一座陡峭的岩壁上。有"茶中之王"美称,名闻海内外;在茶园里,换上制服,体验【亲自采茶,品茶】,了解武夷山茶文化。 体验【高铁(二等座)】返回上饶,转车前往鹰潭市。

## 第7天 鹰潭 龙虎山 (40分钟) 南昌 (2.0 小时) (平/午/晚餐)

【龙虎山】据说东汉中叶时张天师在此炼丹,丹成而龙虎观,山因得名,龙虎山因而也成为中国道教发祥地。龙虎山景区有99峰、24岩、108个景物,丹霞地貌成因多样,有从幼年期、壮年期到老年期丹霞地貌的完整序列,拥有包括峰墙、石林、峰丛等23种丹霞地貌景观。 龙虎山是中国典型的丹霞地貌风景因为雨水、河流的侵蚀崩塌堆积造就了许多奇特的山型:巨象汲水般的象鼻山立于天地般的金枪峰。游览景点:【船游仙水岩】【悬棺表演】【仙女岩】【排衙峰栈道】【无蚊村】【象鼻山】【上清古镇】、【天师府】。游毕,驱车返回南昌,晚餐后入住酒店。

#### 第8天 南昌、古隆坡(早/-/机上用餐)

早餐后,自由逛购【万达广场@金街-午餐自理】这里南昌繁华的商业中心,荟萃各种小吃和游乐设施,游客可在此自由逛街及品尝南昌当地小吃,感受南昌市民生活。午餐后,送往昌北国际机场,搭乘专机返回吉隆坡,结束完美行程。



## 8D7N JIANGXI + WUYISHAN

**DAY 01** KUALA LUMPUR T NAN CHANG (MOB/D)

Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport T1 for flight to Nanchang, Jiangxi Province. Meet and Greet by Local Tour Guide.

Tour of Wanshou Palace Gourmet Cultural Village, consisting of an old residential block, commercial block, religious and cultural block, featuring eight ancient streets and a cluster of historical buildings reflecting the architectural styles during the Qing Dynasty (1644-1911).

NAN CHANG - DONGLIN TEMPLE @ GIANT BUDDHA IJIU JIANG (1.5H) (B/L/D) **DAY 02** 

After breakfast, visit Tengwang Pagoda, the symbol of Nanchang, built in Tang Dynasty and became world-famous due to the "Preface to Prince Teng's Pavilion" written by the poet Wang Bo. It is also known as the "Three Famous Towers in Jiangnan".

Buddha of Donglin Temple, is the birthplace of the Pure Land Sect of Buddhism, it is the tallest Amitabha statue in China and the world. The Buddha statue is 48 meters tall and has a total height of 81 meters. 48 kilograms of gold were used to gild the Big Buddha.

**DAY 03** JIU-JIANG 🖨 JING-DE-ZHEN (1.5H) 🚔 WU YUAN (1.5H) (B/J-/-)

<mark>Jingdezhen</mark> It is the world capital of porcelain and the historic home of the Chinese ceramics industry.

Imperial Kiln, a national intangible cultural heritage (hand-made porcelain) productive protection and research demonstration base. It is an imperial kiln ceramic culture with panoramic reproduction, living inheritance, and true interpretation of the porcelain-making skills of the royal kilns of past dynasties as its core content.

Wu Nuzhou, a comprehensive scenic spot featuring new Hui-style architecture and integrating live performances and cultural attractions.

Night tours being arranged to watch the Water Curtain Light shows and Chinese "intangible cultural heritage" ironwork performance

**DAY 04** WUYUAN 🖨 WANG-XIAN VALLEY (1.0H) 🖨 SHANG RAO (1.5H) (B/J-)

> Huang Ling + Cable rides, surrounded by mountains and creeks, the village and its ancient architectural complex stand in a beautiful natural environment. During the harvest season, hundreds of scattered Hui-style houses under the sun and the colorful harvest fruits on the drying racks form a gorgeous "autumn sun" landscape. Sitting on the cable car, you can overlook the layers of terraced fields below. Tour of Huaxi Water Street, Beauty Pavilion, Sai Qiu Square, Glass Bridge, etc..

> n Valley, it's an admire dreamland of countless people, houses built on the cliff where you can overlook the valley sceneries on top. the valley is long and quiet, with jubilant streams and pebble waterfalls. There are rammed earth walls, bluestone roads, yellow walls and black tiles, and original village houses unique to Jiangxi folk houses; there are also seas of pines and bamboos and unique Ganjia markets. When night falls, the valleys looks like a another paradise out from the world. Featured attractions: Qingyun Bridge, Sandieshui, Lanyue Bridge,

SHANG RAO 🖨 WUYISHAN @ MT. TIAN YOU SCENIC + BAMBOO RAFTING (1.0H) RONG STREET (B/L/D)

Wuyi Mountain @ Tianyou Peak Scenic Area - Tianyou Peak is the most dangerous peak in Wuyi Mountain. Climbing to the top of the peak and looking at the sea of clouds, the ever-changing scenery makes you feel like you are in Penglai Wonderland, traveling in the Heavenly Palace and the Qiong Pavilion, hence the name Tianyou.

Jiuquxi Bamboo Rafting is a stream at the southwest foot of Huanggang Mountain, the main peak of Wuyi Mountains. It is named Jiuqu steam because it has three Bay with nine bends. Rafting on this Jiuqu stream, enjoy the sceneries of both riverbank and mountain landscape.

At Wuyishan town, tour of Wuyi Palace & Song Street, Make tea around the stove. After dinner, check into hotel

DA HONG PAO SCENIC AREA @ TEA PICKING DIY++++ **DAY 06** 

SHANG RAO | YING TAN (1.5H) (B/L/D)

Dahongpao Scenic Area ~ Wuyishan Dahongpao is the most famous tea abroad, it is known as the "King of Teas" and grows on a steep rock wall in Jiulong Nest. In the tea garden, change

into uniforms, experience "picking tea", tasting tea and learn about tea culture.

Thereafter, sit on the **High Speed Train (2nd Class)** heading back to Shang Rao, coach transfer to Ying Tan city.

**DAY 07** YING TAN 🛏 MT. LONGHU SCENIC AREA (40 Min) 🛏 NAN CHANG (2.0H)

Longhu Mountain ~ In Han Dynasty, Master Zhang Tianshi made elixirs here. When the elixir was completed, dragons and tigers appeared, hence the named and Longhu Mountain became the birthplace of Chinese Taoism. Longhu Mountain Scenic Area has 99 peaks, 24 rocks, and 108 scenic spots. The Danxia landforms have diverse from infancy, adulthood to old age. It has

23 kinds of Danxia landforms including peak walls, stone forests, and peak clusters landscape. Tourist attractions: Boat Tour at Xianshui Rock, Hanging Coffin Performance, Fairy Rock, Paiya Peak Plank Road, Mosquito-free Village, Elephant Trunk Mountain, Shangqing Ancient Town, Tianshi Mansion.


Thereafter, coach back to Nanchang city.

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

#### 1. TOUR DEPOSIT

A minimum non-refundable deposit of RM500 or maximum deposit of 25% of the tour fare per person must be paid as reservation fee. The balance of full payment must be made within 35 days before the date of departure for group tours packages. A failure to comply with this requirement may result in the cancellation of reservation and forfeiture of deposit.

#### 2. AMENDMENT CHARGES

#### 2.1 For Group Tour Packages

- Upon confirmation of the tour no changes can be made to the reservation within 14 days before the date of departure.
- However, any request from any member for any change to come back earlier or later than the group will be subject to the conditions of the respective airlines.
- Changing the entire reservation constitutes a cancellation of the original reservation.

## 3. CANCELLATION CHARGES FOR CANCELLATION MADE BY TOUR MEMBER 3.1 For Group Tour Packages

- Cancellation of booking must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding.
   If the company receives notice to cancel 45 working days or more before the date of departure, a minimum administrative fee of RM30.00 per person or 2% of the tour fare (whichever is higher) per person will be levied.
- If notice of the cancellation is received 44 working days or less before the date
  of departure the following charges will apply:-

responsible for any inconvenience caused and extra expenses incurred).

#### 4. CANCELLATION BY COMPANY

#### 4.1 Group Tour Packages

- The company reserves the right to cancel the tour due to any act of God, war, strike, riot or order from the Government of Malaysia which is beyond its control.
- The company shall recommend alternative tours preferably to the same destination or other tours. Should any passenger decide not to accept the alternative tours, all moneys paid less the administrative fee chargeable will be refunded to the passenger.
- In the event of a cancellation by the company due to insufficient passengers or inability to secure seats or accommodation, the company will refund the amount of money paid and also pay compensation as follows:

#### Cancellation Received Cancellation Charges Per Person

08-14 working days before the date of departure - Full refund of tour fare and a compensation of RM50.00 per person.

01-07 working days before the date of departure - Full refund of tour fare and a compensation of RM75.00 per person.

On date of departure - Full refund of tour fare and a compensation of RM100.00 per person.

#### 5. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

#### 5.1 Tour Members' Responsibilities

A tour member must have: -

- An international passport or other recognized travel documents which should be valid for at least 6 months from the date of return to country of origin;
- The necessary visa and vaccination and health certificates as required by the various authorities of the countries to be visited.

#### 5.2 Company's Responsibilities

The Company undertakes to: -

- Advise tour members on what documentation is required;
- Wherever possible, assist passengers in obtaining the necessary visa. However, the company cannot guarantee the approval of any visa application.

#### 5.3 Relevant Fees and Charges

Service charges and visa fees levied shall be borne entirely by the tour members.

#### 5.4 Rejection of Visa or Travel Documents

If for any reason, the application for visa or necessary exit permit is rejected, a refund of tour fare will be made less administrative fees.

#### 5.5 Refusal Entry

The company shall not be held responsible or liable for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of tour prices if any tour member is refused entry or

deported by immigration authorities resulting from the possession of unlawful items or holding improper travel documents or other causes, or whose behavior and activities are considered to be detrimental by a foreign government.

#### 6. TOUR INFORMATION AND PRICES

#### (1) The company covenants for the following to be included in tour fare:-

- Return luggage allowance provided by airlines, Economy Group Class air ticket including airport taxes for both destinations.
- Hotel accommodation, based on:

#### 7. REFUND OF UNUSED SERVICES

#### 8. BAGGAGE

Free airline baggage allowance is provided by the airlines and the quantum and conditions may differ from one airline to another and from one airport authority to another. The same applies for hand-carried baggage aboard the aircraft.

#### 9. POSSIBLE CHANGES

Airlines schedules or local conditions may require sightseeing tours, hotels and route to be changed. Should this occur, the company shall make alternative arrangement subject to local conditions.

#### 10.RIGHT TO REJECT

The company reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any itinerary, or any reservation made for a client or decline to accept or retain any person from being a tour member if he is likely to endanger the health or safety, or impair the comfort or enjoyment of others on the tour. The company further reserves the right to cancel the reservation if for any other reason any carrier, hotel or other contractor refuses to allow any participant to participate in the tours. If any of such events, the company's sole liability shall be to refund to the tour member any moneys paid, less the amounts for services already utilized, and the administration and cancellation fees.

#### 11. RESPONSIBILITY OF COMPANY

The Company and its associated agents shall be held responsible for services provided with regard to transportation, accommodation, entertainment and meals, as indicated in their brochures.
